Conditions of Entry

- The Tournament is sanctioned by the Council of the Lawn Tennis Association and will be conducted under the present Rules and Regulations of the L.T.A.
- Competitors for all events must be qualified to play in the County Championship by either birth qualification for the County of Oxfordshire or residential qualification in the County of Oxfordshire, i.e. have resided in Oxfordshire for the past six months.
- All players are required to wear suitable tennis clothing and footwear.
- Entries close on Friday 22nd June 2007 and must be accompanied by a cheque made out to OLTA and a 1st class SAE and sent to:- Oxfordshire LTA, White Horse Leisure & Tennis Centre, Audlett Drive, Abingdon OX14 B3PJ. You will be sent details of the times and date of your first match a few days before the Tournament starts.
- The Committee reserve the right :-
 - to limit the entry in all events
 - to divide any event into classes, and
 - to cancel any event should the number of entries be low.
- The Committee reserve full power to modify the programme in any way they think proper, subject to compliance in all cases with the Rules and Regulations of the L.T.A., and to refuse any entry without stating a reason.
- The draw for each singles event will be on a progressive and / or staggered knock out basis. This means that players will commence in the draw against similarly rated players.
- The decision of the Referee on all points relating to the running of the Tournament shall be final. No complaint can be considered by the Committee unless submitted in writing within 48 hours of the cause of complaint.
- Play will commence from 6pm – 10pm each day with the finals taking place from 10am – 6pm on Saturday 14th July. In the event of rain the finals will take place on Sunday 15th July.
- All matches are scheduled to take place on outdoor clay courts at the White Horse Leisure & Tennis Centre.
